My work investigates the interplay of identity and representation in relation to power, gender, and ecology, through our connection to nature and each other. It makes space for voices and stories that have been persistently silenced, inviting the public to witness, reflect, and participate in the alchemy of shared memory and collective healing. Rooted in ecofeminism, process philosophy, and critical theory, each work serves as a liminal bridge—guiding viewers from weighted histories of suffering and marginalization to unfolding, transformational narratives.
